I am being sent by my company to provide services in France in the construction and public works sector, and have the nationality of a country outside the European Union, the European Economic Area or Switzerland. Do I have any special rules and procedures to follow ?



You are a foreign worker who is not a national of a Member State of the European Union, the European Economic Area or Switzerland, and you are being sent to work on a construction or public works site in France.

Before arriving in France, you must fulfil reception and residence conditions in France, including, depending on the case, applying for a work permit.

A worker posted to France who is not a national of a Member State of the European Union, the European Economic Area or Switzerland has additional steps to follow when arriving and residing in France for professional purposes.
