I am a foreign company providing a service in France in the construction and public works sector : do I have specific training obligations for my posted workers who will be working on the site ?



General safety training and 'special' training for posted workers are the obligation of the employer in France.

The requirements are the following :

- Qualifications required for certain activities, justified by the possession of a certificate, for example to carry out work in a hyperbaric environment or industrial radiology ;
- Suitable training to be provided to certain categories of workers (e.g. maintenance and repair) and users of work equipment (e.g. driving machinery).
