I am a foreign company providing a service in France in the construction and public works sector : do I have any obligations in terms of accommodation for posted workers working on the site ?



There is no obligation for foreign companies posting staff to France to provide accommodation for the posted workers. However, if the employer provides accommodation for its posted workers, certain rules must be observed.

If the employer or the host company (in the case of the posting of temporary workers by a foreign temporary employment agency) to whom the posted workers are made available, decides to set up collective accommodation arrangements for the posted workers, they must then comply with the relevant provisions of the Labour Code.
